Please install the VSware App on your phone to make sure you receive all school notifications.






POSITIVE BEHAVIOUR

Through VSware we operate a positive behaviour reward system where students are awarded points or commendations for doing something well.


Students respond very positively when their good efforts acknowledged.

YONDR

Every student has a pouch to secure their phone for the school day.

Before school begins each morning (on arrival at the school campus) students are expected to place their phone in their Yondr pouch.

Teachers will have access to unlockers to enable phones to be used for classroom-based learning activities.

Our school reception area is an 'Unlocked Zone'. With permission, a student may briefly access their phone to make a call/ send a message in case of emergency.

If a student needs to contact their parent or vice versa, the office will facilitate a call/message.





YONDR CONTINUED..

At the end of the school day students will unlock their pouches using the UNLOCKERS placed at student exit areas.

The initial feedback from students, teachers and parents is very positive.

We encourage parents to not allow students to have devices in their bedrooms at night, this has impacts on their sleep and on their general wellbeing.
