Dear Parent/ Guardian,

I write to advise that Transition Year French students may participate in the DELF exam. (Diplome d'études en langue française). This is an official qualification awarded by the CIEP, Centre International d'Etudes Pédagogiques and the French Ministry of Education certifying the competency of candidates from outside France in the French Language.

Each student will receive a diploma that corresponds to the level of the Council of Europe's Common European Framework of Reference for languages.

The Delf exam is recognized around the world and the student will receive a diploma valid for the rest of her life!

Beyond just personal satisfaction, the DELF exam represents official proof of students' French language skills in a way that Francophone universities, French grandes écoles and future employers can appreciate.

While this exam will not be compulsory, it is hoped that students will sit it as this has been our main focus throughout the year.

The exam fee is €35. Colaiste Bride will cover €10 euros of this. The process for registering students for the Delf exam will begin shortly. To facilitate this a decision on participation in the exam is required by Monday, March 8th. The exam will be on May 12th 2021.

Students will be informed about collection of €25 closer to the registration date.
