The State Examinations Commission will release preliminary Junior Cycle results from last June's Examinations to schools on October 9th, 2024.

This will be considered a day off school for students who were in 3rd Year last year.

Students receiving results are invited to the school sports hall to attend a short assembly at 9:30am where transcripts of results will be distributed.

Parents of last year's 3rd Year group are also invited to join us. Tea/coffee/light refreshments will be available.

TY students who wish to do not have to attend their Work Experience scheduled for Wednesday, they should inform their employer if they will not be available.

5th Year students, who are receiving results, can return home or have the option to attend the rest of their timetabled classes on Wednesday. Students who are receiving results and not returning to class do not need to wear their uniform on the day.

Your child will receive a letter from the State Examinations Commission which includes a PIN number which will enable them to view their results online from 4.00pm on Wednesday if they so wish.

At a later date, once the State Examinations Commission have given guidance, students will be issued with a formal *Junior Cycle Profile of Achievement* which will also include Class Based Assessment Descriptors and Other Areas of Learning Information.
