






#### Leaving Certificate

#### Applied Maths


Applied Maths is also available as an optional subject (pending sufficient numbers)

#### 1 Minimum Entry Requirements

· "Matriculation requirements"

 What you have to have before you can be considered at all.



### Minimum Entry Requirements Example

4 Subjects: 06/H7



6 Subjects

English or Irish: 06/H7



### Standard Minimum Entry Requirements


Min. Entry Requirements	Qualification Title/Level
2H5 grades 406/H7 grades	Honours Degree (Level 8)
506/H7 grades	Ordinary Degree (Level 7) & Higher Certificate (Level 6)
*3H5 grades 306/H7 grades	*Honours Degree in certain Institutions/Courses (e.g. Trinity; Primary Teaching)



#### 2 Specific Course Requirements

 These are particular subjects or combination of subjects that you must have to get a place in a specific course.





## Example of Specific Course Requirements



Minimum Subjects: 2H5 & 406/H7


Specific Course Req.: English 06/H7,

Irish 06/H7, Maths 06/H7, A Third Language 06/H7, Chemistry (H5).



- Each student is **personally responsible** for checking all Minimum Entry and Specific Course Requirements!





#### 3 Points

Those who meet the minimum entry and specific course requirements are allocated places on the basis of points gained from their SIX best subjects.



#### Grades & Common Points Scale

#### Higher Level

Grade (%)	Points
H1 (90-100)	100
H2 (80<90)	88
H3 (70<80)	77
H4 (60<70)	66
H5 (50<60)	56
H6 (40<50)*	46
H7 (30<40)	37

#### Ordinary Level

Grade (%)	Points
O1 (90-100)	56
O2 (80<90)	46
O3 (70<80)	37
<i>O</i> 4 (60<70)	28
<i>O</i> 5 (50<60)	20
O6 (40<50)	12



\*25 Bonus points are awarded for HL Maths for H6\*and above.



#### LCVP Link Modules

 All HEIs award <u>points</u> for results in LCVP Link Modules, in place of a 6<sup>th</sup> subject.

Grade	Points
Distinction	66
Merit	46
Pass	28





#### LCVP Acceptance

- LCVP <u>is</u> a Senior Cycle Programme; it is '\( \frac{1}{2} \) not a 'subject'.
- LCVP <u>may not be acceptable</u> for meeting Minimum Entry Requirements.
- Example: Honours Bachelor Degree requires <u>6</u> subjects.





#### LCVP Acceptance

- Important if you have a <u>reduced number</u> of Leaving Certificate subjects (e.g. <u>6</u>)
- Especially relevant to students <u>not</u> studying <u>Irish</u>.
- · Speak to Ms. Murphy (SENCO) if unsure.


- Check with course provider whether Foundation Level subjects are:
- 1) Acceptable
- 2) Awarded points(e.g. Foundation Level Maths)




#### Language Pointers

As well as English and Irish a
Third Language is required for
many of the courses in colleges
of the National University of
Ireland (NUI)\*

\*UCD, UCC, NUI Galway, Maynooth University, Shannon College of Hotel Management, RCSI, NCAD, Burren College of Art, IPA, IOB, etc.



# Exceptions to Third Language Requirement



Third Language <u>not</u> required for courses such as:

- Nursing
- Engineering
- Science
- Agriculture
- NCAD will accept Art instead of the third language, etc.

#### NUI Exemptions


Any 6<sup>th</sup> Year student who is <u>not</u> taking <u>Irish and/or a Third Language</u> in the L.C. & intends to apply to an NUI college <u>may need</u> to apply to NUI for a language exemption (Irish and/or a Third Language).

#### Other College Exemptions


· If a student has an Irish and /Third Language Exemption, and is applying for a course(s) in a non-NUI college where Irish/Third language is an essential requirement, an application for that exemption needs to be made to EACH **COLLEGE** (e.g. University of Limerick, Trinity, etc.)



N.B. Contact <u>each college</u> for their individual application process!

#### Additional Educational Needs Co-ordinator (AENCO)

- Students are encouraged to speak to the AENCO (Ms. Murphy) if unsure about Exemptions/Subject Choice.
- N.B. It is <u>your responsibility</u> to apply for any exemption(s) that may be required!









### Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Agricultural Science

#### Science Pointers

If applying for anything in the Engineering, Medical, Paramedical (Radiography, Physiotherapy, Human Nutrition/Dietician, Pharmacy, Medical Laboratory Science, etc.) or Science areas at Universities you need to pass at least one Laboratory Science subject.

#### Science Pointers Cont....

- You need a Science subject for Nursing (Biology advisable).
- Some courses require TWO Science subjects (e.g. Medicine, and Dentistry in UCC require a H4 in Chemistry and a H4 in Physics or Biology).

#### Science Not Required

- Technological Universities (TUs) Higher Certificate/Ordinary Degree courses in Science or Engineering do not require science, but it would be useful.
- Universities Arts, Commerce, Social
   Science, Law, etc. do not require science.




#### Agricultural Science

 Although Agricultural Science is accepted as a laboratory science subject by Third Level colleges, it may <u>NOT</u> always meet the <u>Specific</u> <u>Subject Requirements</u> of a particular course.

• E.g. Medicine in Trinity will <u>not</u> accept Agricultural Science in <u>combination</u> with Biology.






#### Business Pointers

None required for most Business, Marketing or Commerce courses, but they would help if you wanted to do such a course.






### Artistic Group Art, Music






#### Artistic Pointers


Not always essential for Art or Music courses, but recommended as a portfolio/audition/music test is likely to be a requirement.









# Humanities Pointers


Getting to understand your world either in terms of how it got to be this way (History) or how it is laid out and utilised (Geography) is an important factor in any education

# Social Pointers


Home Economics <u>may</u> be a requirement for certain H.E. teaching courses.

Religious Education is not a requirement for any course; but recommended for further study in this area.

Physical Education may be a requirement for some courses; is recommended in advance of further P.E. study.

# How Many Optional Subjects?


- Each student must Choose <u>4</u> Optional Subjects.
- Students are strongly advised to include a <u>Third Language</u> as one of these; as it will help to keep options open.



# Subject Level and Demand

 All optional subjects can be taken at either Higher or Ordinary Level.


