Dear Parent/Guardian,

As you know there will be no Junior Certificate exams for students this year. Each student will receive a certificate of completion issued by the State Examinations Commission and will receive a school report of the assessment of the student's learning in each of their subjects. The final report will describe the broad range of learning that students have achieved in each subject.

The final grade that your daughter will receive in each subject have two components:

- Third Year students will complete a final formal school administered Junior Cycle exam. Exam papers will assess students learning from 1st to 3rd Year.
- The remaining portion will be allocated by subject teachers using a range of evidence to inform their assessment of students' achievements including assignments, class tests, End of Term Exams, projects, practical work and/or Classroom-Based Assessments completed in second year and third year.

We believe that our approach to allocating a final grade to Third Year students is fair and will help to keep students motivated, focused and engaged for the last few weeks of the school year. It will also be an opportunity for students to demonstrate the depth and breadth of learning over the three years of the Junior Cycle.
